

BARRY-ROUBAIX INSTRUCTIONS

- Welcome to the Barry-Roubaix, please read the following information to make your race more enjoyable
- Packet pick up will take place Saturday from 7:30a.m.-9:30a.m. at the Gun Lake Open Shelter.(no Friday pick up this year) We highly recommend you pick-up packets early on Saturday. All raffle prizes will be labeled by the racers number and available during packet pick up and until the end of the race. Simply claim your prize at anytime by showing your race number or driver's license to a volunteer at the prize table.
- All vehicles entering the Gun Lake Unit will need a [\\$10 Michigan State Park motor vehicle passport](#) or a daily pass for \$8. Michigan residents please have vehicle passports purchased in advance to speed up the entrance to the parking area come race day. Out of state racers may purchase a daily pass for \$8 or annual for \$29 on site.
- No I-Pods or mp3 players allowed
- **Littering of any kind is not allowed and will be grounds for disqualification**
- Disposable Championship Timing Chips are fastened to your number plate in advance. Number plates must be handlebar mounted. Handlebar mounting eliminates scoring errors. Do not remove the timing chip sticker on the back of your number! Do not trim you number plates down! Timing is in a Time Trial format (just like Iceman) to eliminate a 1500 person mass start!
- This race course is open to traffic, obey all traffic laws and the instructions of Sheriff Marshals at intersections, and only roll through if you are directed to do so.
- **I repeat, the course will *NOT* be closed to traffic and cycling rules of the road apply**, i.e. stop at all stop signs, yield to cars, no more than 2 riders abreast and do not cross yellow center line. Violations will be penalized by disqualification.
- Please ride smart, your life and the life of others is more important than this race
- We are not responsible for citations issued by a sheriff for not following the rules of the road.
- The race starts at 10:00 a.m. with four waves approximately 2 minutes apart. 1st wave 61 milers, 2nd and 3rd wave 35 milers split into two groups determined by age on race day and the 4th wave is the 23 milers. Each wave will consist of a neutral roll out to the Park exit at which time the wave will be racing. **Starting in the wrong wave will result in disqualification!**
- **The most important intersections are Head Lake and Little Pine Lake Rd; we will have it clearly marked with signage and volunteers. 23 mile racers turn left and 35/61 mile racers turn right. The next intersection to make note of is at Head Lake and Wilkins Rd where 35 milers turn left and 61 milers turn right.**
- Crew, family and friends please stand completely off Sager Rd during the start of the race and **do not even think of parking on Sager Rd!** Crews are not allowed to follow racers (via bike, car, scooter, etc) during the race. 61 mile racers may only receive hand-ups from friends or family at the aid stations listed on the map.

- We will provide sweep vehicles if you need a ride back to the finish line. They will not be carrying a full assortment of repair items so carry your own emergency items and know how to use them. **Please let race officials know if you drop out. Everyone must be accounted for.**
- **Please do not cool down on portions of the race course. Use the parking area only.**
- Electronic results are furnished by Race Services immediately following your race, check results on the monitors under the results canopy. When results are posted, riders will have 30 minutes to verify any discrepancies. After that results are final. The race is scored as a time trial, this means someone in wave two of the 35 mile race could beat someone's time in wave one.
- **23 mile awards held at noon, 35 mile awards held at 1:30 and 61 mile awards held at 2:00. If you finish in the top three please attend.**
- Velocity wheelset raffle: A standard raffle will take place after the awards ceremonies but you must be present to win! Other unclaimed prizes will be raffled off at our discretion at this time. We will hand out tickets at this time.
- **Use extreme caution when leaving the parking area; racers may be entering the finish area.**
- **Take note of the new and improved start/finish layout**
